

# **Recruitment Brochure of Degree Program for International Students in Hainan Medical University (2025)**

## **Introduction of Hainan Medical University**

Hainan Medical University is located in Haikou, the provincial capital of Hainan Province, a tropical coastal city known as the "Coconut City", formerly known as HaiQiang Medical Technology School founded in 1947 and the private Hainan University Medical College founded in 1948. The university now has three campuses: Chengxi (main campus), Guilinyang (new campus), and Longhua, covering an area of 1416.71 acres. Adhering to the motto of "virtue, rigor, erudition, harmony," the university continues to promote the spirit of "self-improvement, unity, and vigor," and has built a six-in-one medical education system that integrates "teaching-clinic-research-international cooperation-social service-cultural heritage." It has cultivated more than 70,000 high-quality medical and health talents for the country. It is the first batch of national pilot universities for the excellent doctor education and training program, the first batch of comprehensive reform pilot universities of the Ministry of Education, the construction unit of high level university of Hainan Province, the leading unit of National Emergency Medical Rescue Team (Hainan), and has fully embarked on a new era of independently cultivating high-level medical talents in Hainan.

The university has established a comprehensive and multi-level talent cultivation system that covers full-time undergraduate and postgraduate (master's and doctoral) education, international student education, adult education, and continuing education. Currently, there are 15,340 full-time students, including 12,207 undergraduates (with 633 international students) and 1,760 master's and doctoral students. Students have won multiple national level awards, including the first prize in innovation and entrepreneurship for pharmaceutical and traditional Chinese medicine college students, as well as the China Undergraduate Mathematical Contest in Modeling, the National Computer Design Competition for College Students, the National Life Science Competition, and the Inter-Medical School Physiology Quiz,IMSPQ in China.The university has a faculty and medical staff of 11,834, including 1,100 full-time teachers. Among them, there are 749 at the main campus, with 479 holding senior professional technical titles, 163 professors, and nearly 51.27% with doctoral degrees. It has 1

academician of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, 2 National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars, 1 Chang Jiang Scholar, 7 national candidates of "100 million talents project", 4 national outstanding teachers, and 1 famous teacher of traditional Chinese medicine, 5 selected by the Ministry of Education for the "New Century Excellent Talent Support Program" and 15 Hainan Province's "Double Hundred Talents Team."

The university offers 36 undergraduate majors in 4 disciplines, including medicine, science, and management, and has 5 national first-class undergraduate majors, 2 national specialties, 1 national experimental teaching demonstration center, 1 national clinical teaching training demonstration center. The university has 3 of the largest tertiary A-level directly affiliated hospitals in the province, with a total of 7,020 open beds. The annual number of outpatient and emergency patients was 5.8809 million, and the number of discharged patients was 257,300, accounting for 12.64% and 21.13% of the total in the province, respectively. This has made significant contributions to Hainan Province's efforts to prevent major illnesses from leaving the island and clinical teaching. Additionally, it has 10 non-affiliated affiliated hospitals, 12 teaching hospitals, and 2 cooperative disease control centers, providing strong support for clinical teaching. It has 15 national clinical key specialties and 7 provincial key disciplines. Clinical medicine ranks in the top 5% of ESI disciplines, and pharmacology and toxicology rank in the top 1% of ESI disciplines. Currently, there are 5 first-level doctoral degree programs in clinical medicine, 5 master degree programs in basic medicine, clinical medicine, pharmacy, traditional Chinese medicine and biology, and 5 professional master degree programs in clinical medicine, public health, nursing, pharmacy and stomatology.

## Part II How to Apply

Applicants should apply online by logging into the International Student Application Service System of Hainan Medical University within the application period stipulated by Hainan Medical University at <https://ism.muhn.edu.cn/stu/> or download and fill in the relevant materials on the website of the School of International Education of the school at <http://www.hainmc.edu.cn/sole/>, submit them to the email address: [hnmu\\_enquire@muhn.edu.cn](mailto:hnmu_enquire@muhn.edu.cn).

Applications are generally available from February - end of July each year, and applicants are advised to complete their applications at least by mid-July. For scholarship applications, please complete your application by May 20th.

## Part III List of Application Requirements and Materials

### Submit the following application materials

#### 1. Undergraduate Program

(1) Basic personal requirements: age: 18-35 years old (self-financed students can be appropriately relaxed); non-Chinese citizens holding valid foreign ordinary passports; abiding by Chinese laws, regulations and school rules and regulations; Being honest and trustworthy, and being in good health;

(2) Personal statement and study plan;

(3) Certification report of academic qualifications: in principle, a high school diploma or equivalent notarized by the local education department must be provided;

(4) Transcripts: transcripts of high school graduation (notarized documents must be submitted);

(5) Language Proficiency Score Report: Applicants must provide the score report of the corresponding level of the Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) or the score report of an English - proficiency test, as required by the program they are applying for. (HSK Level 4 or above is required for Chinese - medium programs, and HSK Level 3 or above for English - medium programs);

(6) Passport: Applicants are required to provide the personal information page of their private ordinary passports (the validity period of the passport must be more than 1 year).Those who were originally Chinese citizens but later joined foreign nationalities must also provide: Household Registration Cancellation Certificate and Proof of Acquisition of Foreign Nationality;

(7) Application form: Download the Application Form for International Students of Hainan Medical University from the website and fill in then submit it;

(8) Other materials: personal physical examination report; notarized certificate of no criminal record; other materials that can prove your comprehensive ability can be submitted according to the actual situation.

## **2. Master's Degree Program**

(1)Basic Personal Requirements: Applicants must be no more than 38 years old (self - financed students may be subject to a relaxed age limit); non - Chinese citizens holding valid foreign passports; abiding by Chinese laws, regulations, and school rules and regulations; characterized by honesty and trustworthiness, and in good health;

(2) Personal statement and study plan (more than 1000 words);

(3) Degree certificate and degree certification report: Applicants majoring in master's degree programs should submit the original bachelor's degree certificate; Applicants who have obtained their degree certificates from universities outside China must, in principle, submit the degree certification report issued by the *Chinese Service Center for Scholarly Exchange (CSCSE)*.Applicants who have obtained their degree certificates from universities in China must, in principle, submit the degree authentication report issued by the *China Higher Education Student Information Network*. (recent graduates may first submit a certificate of expected graduation. The degree certificate and degree authentication report must be submitted before

enrollment). Applicants who have already graduated should provide the authentication report of the degree certificate at the time of application;

(4) Transcripts: complete transcripts of the undergraduate period must be submitted;

(5) Two letters of recommendation: the referees must be associate professors or scholars with corresponding titles or senior professionals in related industries;

(6) Passport: Applicants must provide the personal information page of their personal passports (the validity of the passport must be more than one year). Those who were originally Chinese citizens but later acquired foreign nationalities must also provide the following documents: proof of household registration cancellation, proof of acquisition of foreign nationality;

(7) Application Form for Admission: Download Application Form for International Students of Hainan Medical University from the official website of School of International Education of Hainan Medical University, fill in and submit;

(8) Other materials: personal physical examination report; notarized certificate of no criminal record; other materials that can prove your comprehensive ability can be submitted according to the actual situation.

### **3. Notes**

(1) In addition to the above materials, a color standard ID photo, not more than 200kb, with support for \*.jpg, \*.jpeg, png as the picture suffix, and pixels greater than 295 \* 413;

(2) Application materials submitted will not be returned, regardless of acceptance or non-acceptance. personal information, documents and certificates provided should be true and accurate, otherwise will be disqualified from applying, admission or study;

(3) If the language of the certificates is neither English nor Chinese, please submit notarized translations in Chinese or English;

(4) The Admissions Department may request applicants to provide the original copies of their application materials or documents certified by an authorized certification body for further verification;

(5) The applicant's contact telephone number and e-mail address must be provided with the application materials;

(6) Applicants for undergraduate education are required to take an entrance examination organized by the University as a reference for admission.

## **Part IV Application and Admission**

## **1. Application for admission**

Applicants send all application materials to the school's designated email address before the application deadline: *hnmu\_enquire@muhn.edu.cn*.

## **2. Application and registration deadline**

May 20, 2025, deadline for Hainan Provincial Government international student scholarship applications;

July 15, 2025, deadline for self-funded student applications;

September 15, 2025, registration deadline.

## **3. Qualification review and assessment**

Qualification review and entrance assessment of the candidates will be conducted to determine the proposed admission list, and the admission notices will be issued.

## **4. Admission letter**

After the university confirms the students' intention to study, the university will send the Letter of Admission and Application Form for Visa for Foreign Students Coming to China (JW202) to the applicants.

## **5. Special notes**

Applicants who cannot register as scheduled should submit relevant supporting documents to our school to ask for leave in advance. The maximum leave period is four weeks. Only after approval can they defer enrollment; otherwise, admission qualification will be canceled.

In accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of China, international students are required to reside in university - provided student dormitories during their first year, unless there are special reasons. From the second year onwards, students may submit applications and relevant housing materials to request permission to rent accommodation off - campus near the university, in compliance with the relevant management regulations. All fees are to be settled in Chinese Yuan (RMB).

## Part VI. Scholarship Application

The scholarship programs offered by Hainan Medical University include the Hainan Government Scholarship for International Students and the ASEAN Scholarship. The duration of funding for undergraduate programs is 4-6 years, depending on the program's education system, while for master's programs, it is 3 years. The funding covers tuition fees, accommodation fees, and medical insurance fees. Other expenses are to be borne by the students themselves.

### 1. Scholarship application condition

(1) Meeting the eligibility criteria for the academic degree programs for international students at our university;

(2) Receiving no Chinese Government Scholarship or any other types of scholarships.
